ONSTER

WHAT YOU NEED

- Pencil
- Felt Thread Pins
- Paper
- Stuffing
- Scissors
- Needle Buttons

WHAT YOU DO

- 1. Draw a monster on a piece of paper.
- Cut out the monster to use as a pattern.
- 3. Lay the monster pattern on top of 2 pieces of felt. Pin the pattern and felt pieces together.
- 4. Cut the pattern from the felt. Remove the pins.

- Pin the 2 monster-shaped felt pieces together. With the needle and thread, sew the pieces together along the edges. Leave an opening near the head for stuffing. Remove the pins.
- 6. Fill the monster with stuffing. Use a pencil to push stuffing into the hard-to-reach areas.
