After I read cartoonist Alison Bechdel's memoir *Fun Home*, I was delighted to learn she had written a follow-up sequel to it. In *Are You My Mother?: A Comic Drama*, Bechdel explores the nuances of her uneasy relationship with her mother in light of the loss they both experience in the wake of her father's suicide. Like *Fun Home*, *Are You My Mother?* is also a graphic novel-type of memoir, and here, the author's carefully crafted frames so richly reveal the same self-awareness and self-censorship she articulates in the dialogue. The charm of Bechdel's drawings and engaging narrative was so spellbinding that I stayed up late into the wee hours to finish the book. By turns darkly depressing, psychologically insightful, and absolutely hilarious, *Are You My Mother?* is sure to resonate with adult readers interested in family relationships and questions of self-identity.
