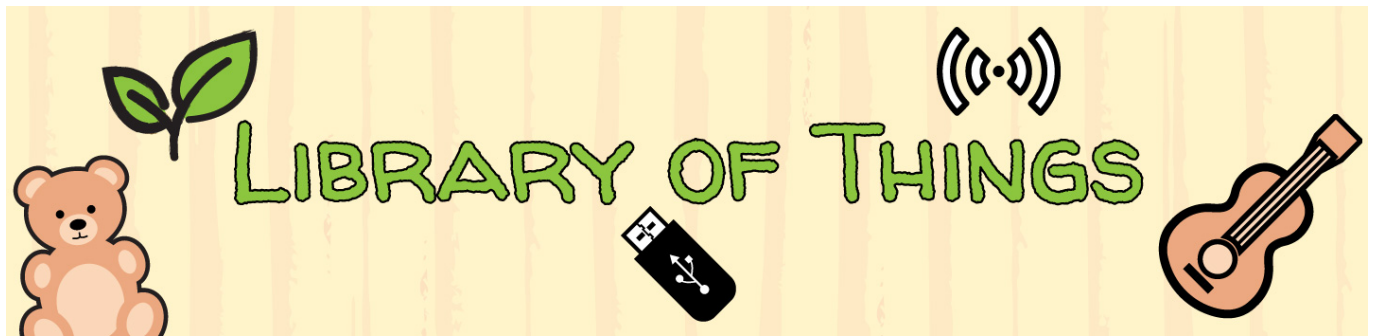


## [Library of Things](#)

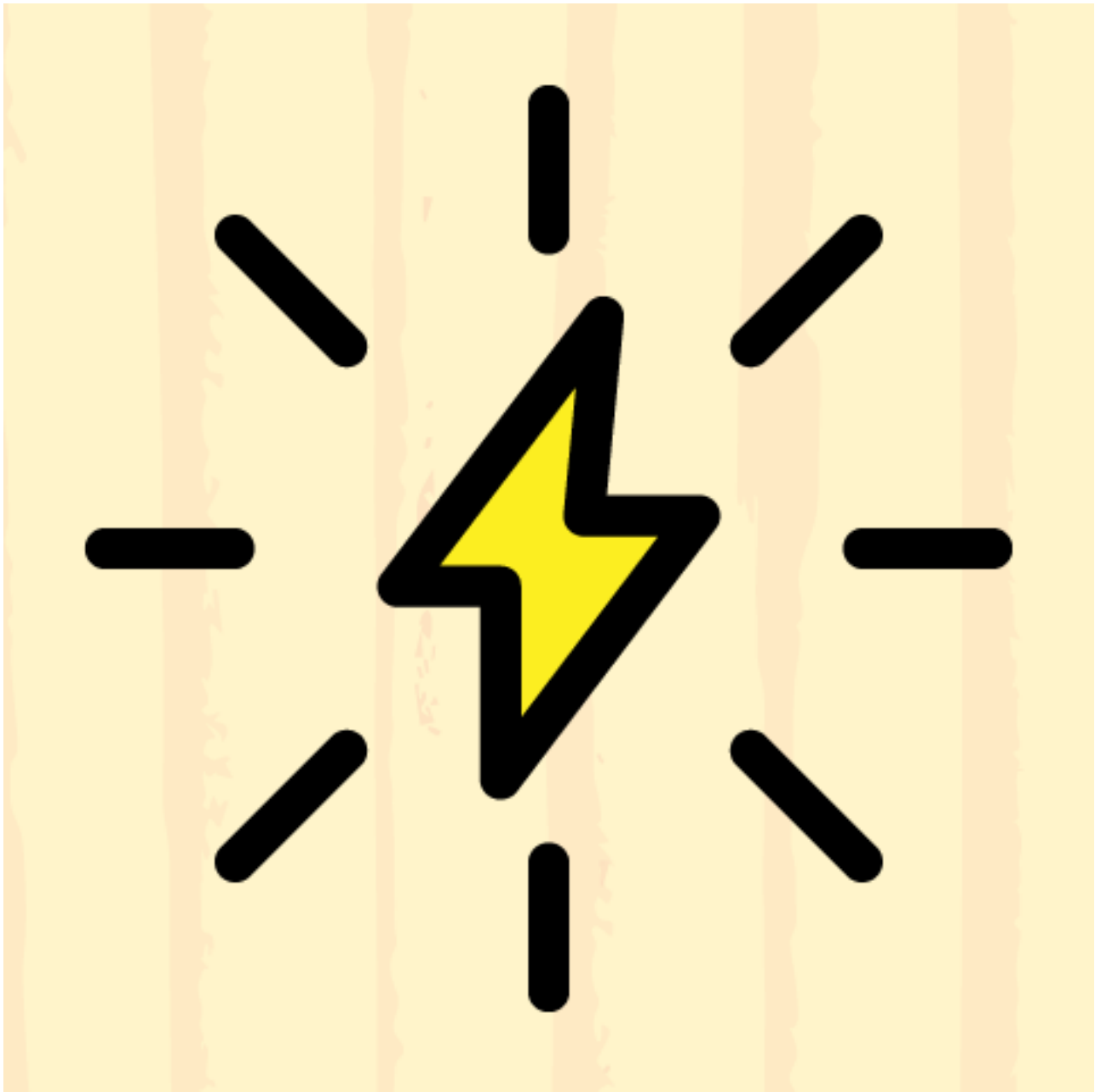
## [Book Club Kits](#)

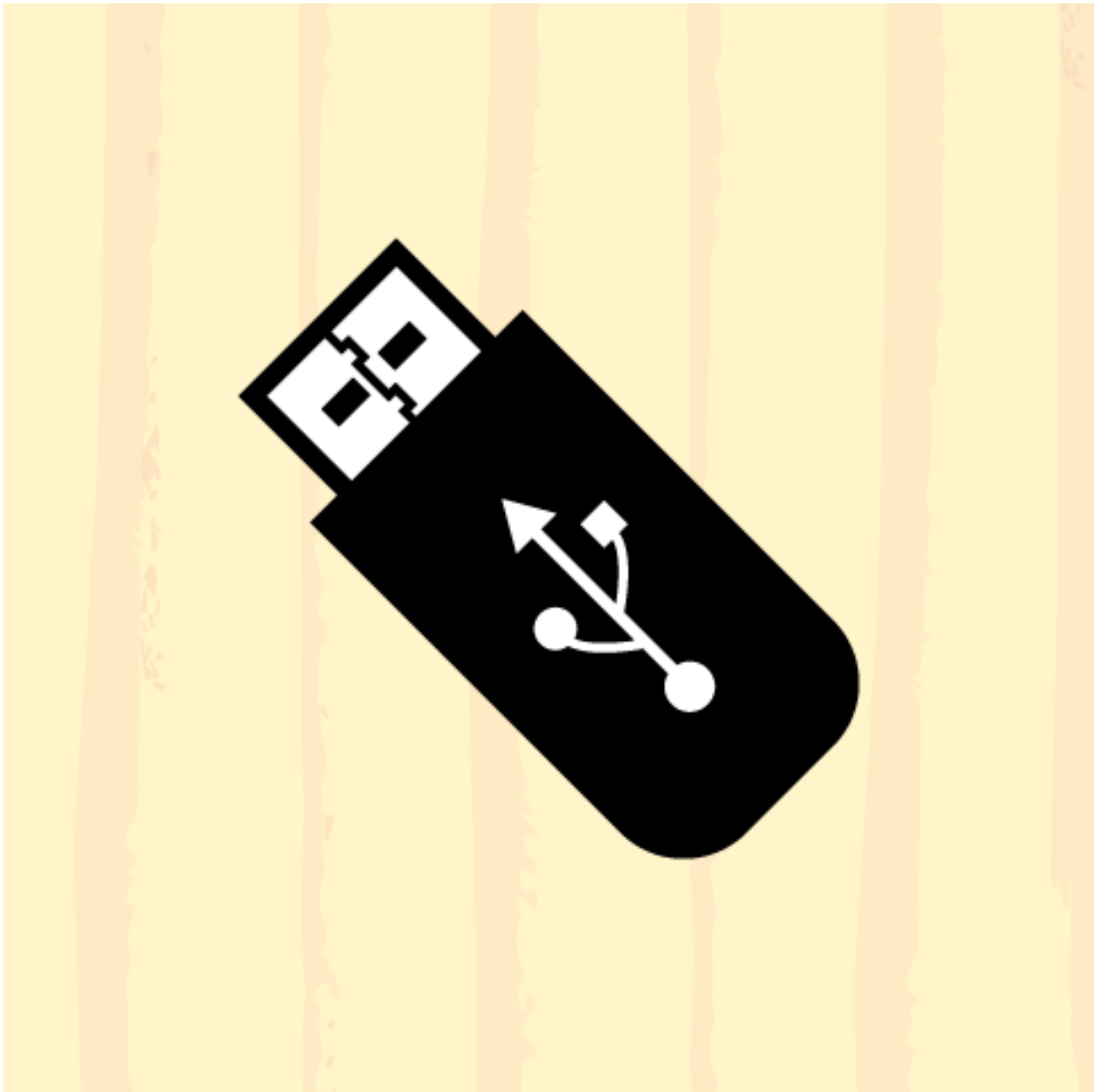
## Calculators

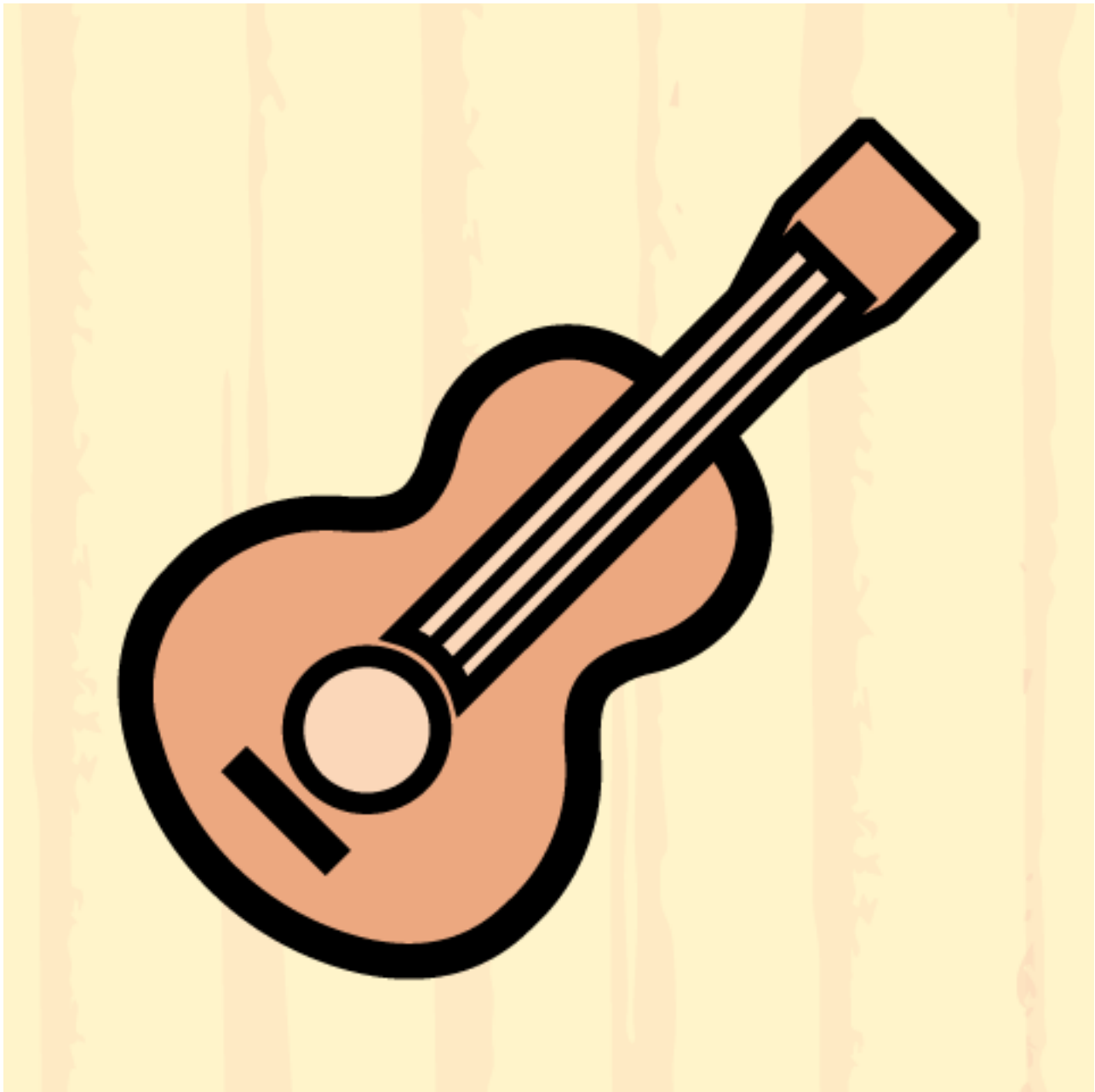
## [Take and Make Kits](#)
