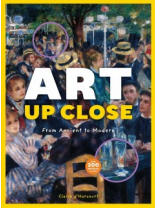

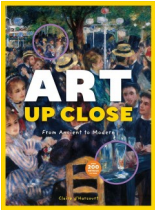


### **Art Appreciation**
