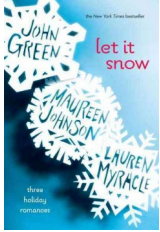

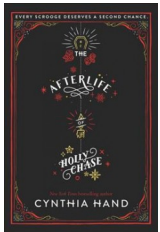

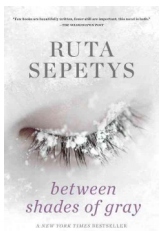


The Afterlife of Holly Chase

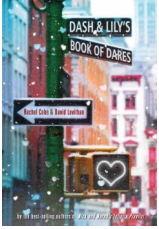


Between Shades of Gray

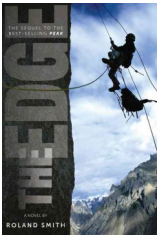


Dash and Lily's Book of Dares

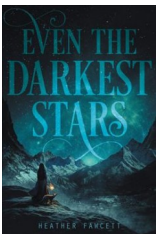


The Edge

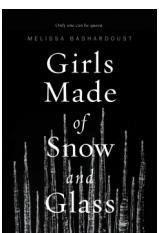


Even the Darkest Stars

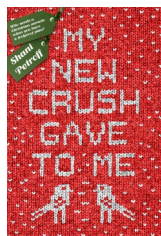


Let It Snow

In three intertwining short stories, several high school couples experience the trials and tribulations of romance along with its joys during a Christmas Eve snowstorm in a small town.

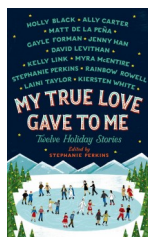


My New Crush Gave to Me

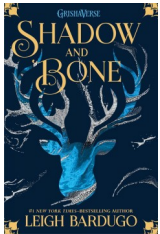


My True Love Gave to Me

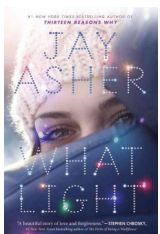


Shiver
