


Additional Appropriation: General Obligation Bond 2013

The Library will pay off its current bond in mid-2012. As a result, County Option Income Tax (COIT) receipts will fall nearly \$500,000 by 2014 and remain at that level thereafter.



In the 2008 survey, Monroe County residents recommended increasing tax revenues and user fees and raising funds, rather than reducing hours, staff, collections or other services.






COIT Decrease/Bond Opportunity


To replace the \$500,000 COIT reduction in 2013, we propose two actions:

- 1. Issue a three-year, \$1,800,000 public works bond (purple) to cover building repair/renovation & equipment/technology needs. As a result, the library's tax rate would be reduced from \$.11 to \$.09 per \$100 AV; the Library could maintain most services and hours.
- Combine Library Capital Projects Fund (LCPF) (red) into the Operating Fund (blue) in 2013.



Taxpayers will see a reduction in Library property taxes in 2012 and after. If adopted, a three-year public works bond would add back a small fraction. On a \$150,000 home with an assessed value of \$65,250, the total Library tax would go from \$71.58 in 2011 to \$60.72 in 2015.


