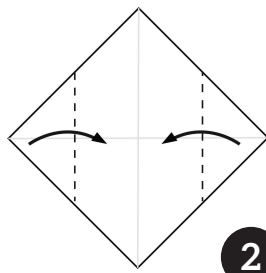


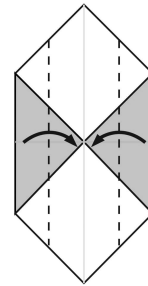

Step 1: Fold and unfold the paper in half both ways.



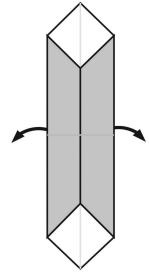

Step 2: Fold both sides in to the centre along the dotted lines.



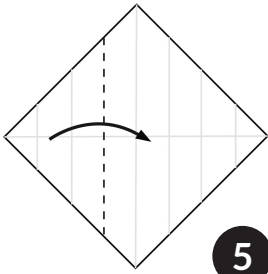

Step 3: Fold both sides in to the centre along the dotted lines.



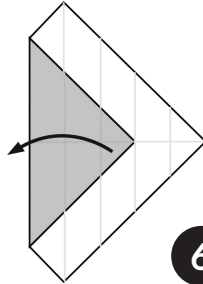

Step 4: Open up the paper completely.



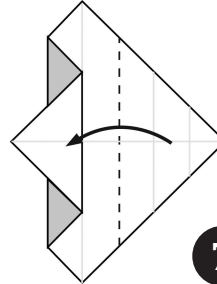

Step 5: Fold the paper over along the dotted line.



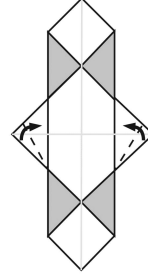

Step 6: Fold the paper back out over to the left.



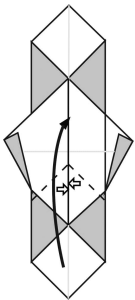

Step 7: Fold the right side of the paper over along the dotted line and then fold it back out like on the other side.



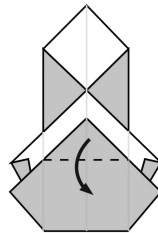

Step 8: Make a small fold on each side along the dotted lines.



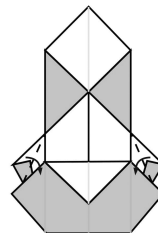

Step 9: Open up the paper along the dotted lines. Lift it up and push it flat. Look at the next diagram to see the final position of this fold.



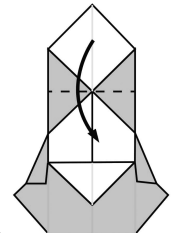

Step 10: Fold the top of the top layer of paper down along the dotted line.



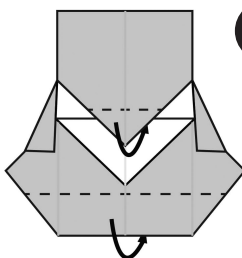

Step 11: Fold both sides in along the dotted lines.



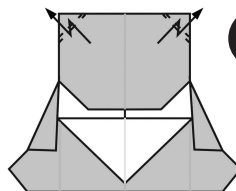

Step 12: Fold the top of the paper down along the dotted line.



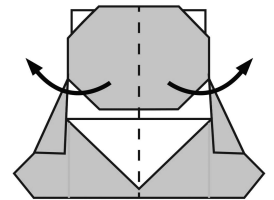

Step 13: Fold the paper underneath along both the dotted lines.



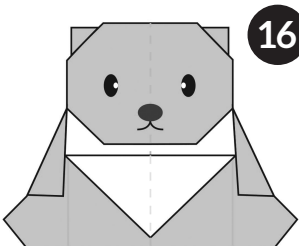

The complete teddy bear

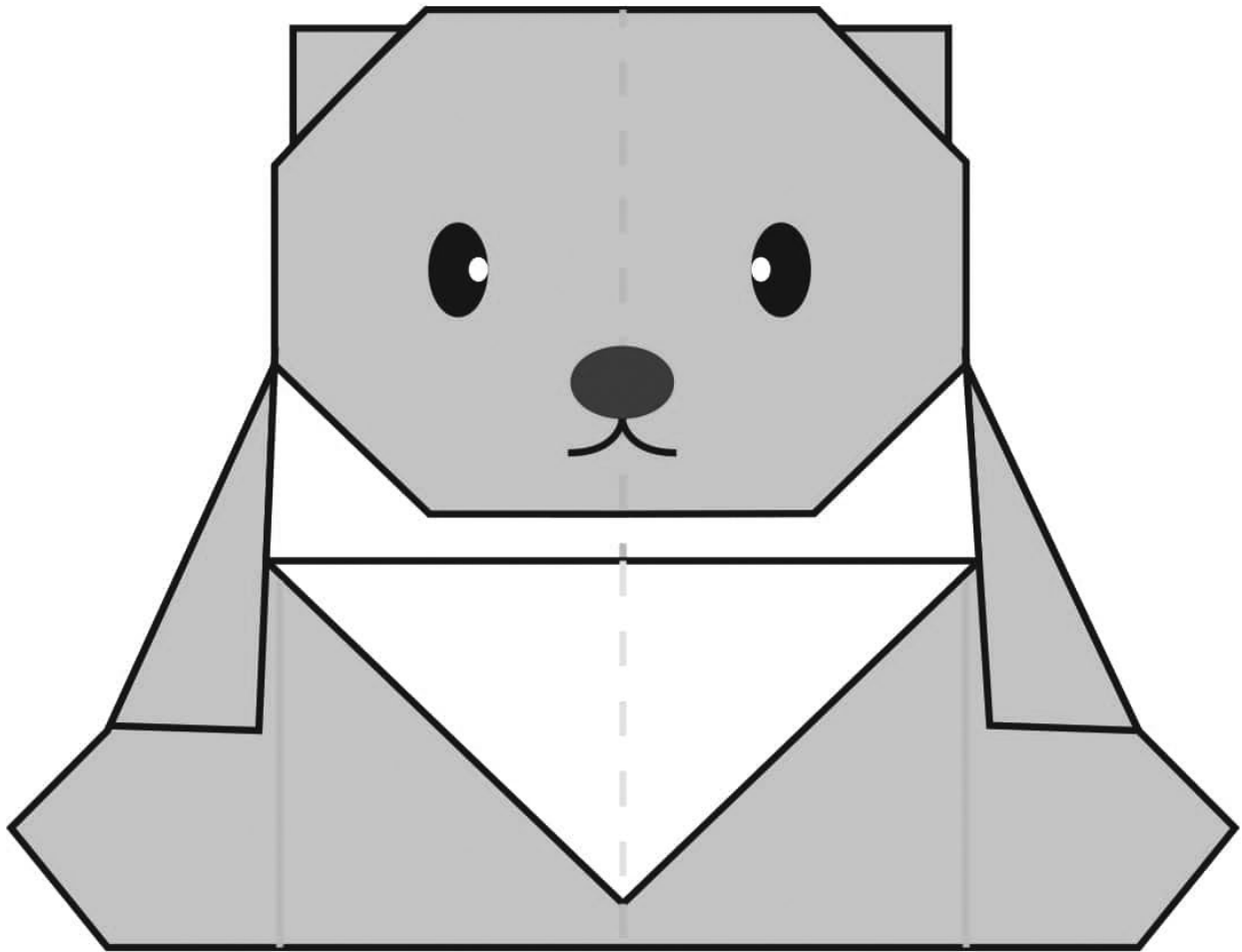
