


***Bent Heavens* by Daniel Kraus


***The Bone Houses*



Lupe Dávila and Javier Utierra try to solve a series of grisly murders sweeping through Puerto Rico before the killer catches up with them.




The Girl From the Well by Rin Chupeco

Following her father's sudden death, Jane and her mother are forced to move to the old North house in Maine, where Jane uncovers her family's disturbing secrets.




The Night Weaver by Monique Snyman

(Young Adult Fiction – Y Schaeff)



After Ollie's school bus mysteriously breaks down on a field trip, she has to take a trip through scary woods, and must use all of her wits to survive. She must stick to small spaces.




Rules for Vanishing


Spirit Hunters by Ellen Oh




Wilder Girls by Rory Power


***Basketful of Heads*


***The Last Halloween*
